COMPOUND WORDS IN SONG LYRICS OF WESTLIFE UNBREAKABLE V1 GREATEST HITS ALBUM BEGINNING 1999-2002

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Abstrak : Penelitian ini difokuskan untuk meneliti jenis kata majemuk dan makna kontekstual dari kata majemuk dalam Lirik Lagu Westlife Unbreakable V1 Greatest Hits Album Awal 1999-2002. Penelitian ini menggunakan penelitian kuantitatif deskriptif. Objeknya adalah 20 Lagu. Langkah-langkah analisis data adalah identifikasi, klasifikasi dan deskripsi. Temuan ini membuktikan bahwa ada tiga jenis kata majemuk. Mereka lima puluh tiga kata dikategorikan sebagai endosentris, tujuh belas kata dikategorikan sebagai eksosentris, dan dua puluh delapan kata dikategorikan sebagai copulative..

Abstract : This study focused to investigate types of compound word and contextual meaning of compound words in the Song Lyrics of Westlife Unbreakable V1 Greatest Hits Album Beginning 1999-2002. This study applied the descriptive quantitative research. The objects were 20 Songs. The steps of data analyzing were identification, classification and description. The findings proved that there were three types of compound words. They were fifty three words categorized as the endocentric, seventeen words categorized as exocentric, and twenty eight words categorized as copulative.

INTRODUCTION

Learning English can be expressed through music, readers use it to build a communication with other. They can use their own language and style to express feeling and emotion by write it into a lyric. Syllado (1983: 23) has stated that music nowadays is regarded as the universal language; music is an art and science of combining vocal and instrument sound or tone in varying melody, harmony, rhythm, and timbre, especially so as to form

structurally complete and emotionally expressive compositions (Webster, 1988: 894). In a shorter definition, music means the arrangement of sound or tones in particular form played on particular instruments According to Greek history, music occupied a main part as an expression of thinking and feeling (Syllado, 1983; IV). There are many kinds of music such as rock, jazz, pop, R&B, and rap. All those kinds of music has spread everywhere, including to our

country. Western music are branding a lot of singers who are very famous, like Britney Spears, Bryan Adams, Blue, Westlife. Music can express feeling and emotion. It is a universal language, so it can touch heart and any aspects of human life when we enjoy it. Nowadays, music has a wider connotation since it still has a rule when it is demonstrated; it is beautiful with the existence of the element of rhyme, tone, and harmony. Through its different lyric, music can arise the feeling of love, sadness, hope and happiness.

The study of word patterns in the song lyrics becomes more important when the words are combined into new words in the song lyrics because sometimes we find the words which have different interpretation. The study of words patterns is morphology. It is concerned with the study of how words is formed in language. Morphology is the study of the internal structures of word, how it is formed by the smaller pieces. According to Booij (2005: 4) morphology is a subdiscipline of linguistics that deals with such patterns. Therefore, morphology deals with the internal constituent structure of words as well. A new word can be formed naturally because of the habits, environments and changing times. This study discussed about words that are created through the process of word formation, specifically compounding.

Compounding is the process of bringing together two or more words into a single entity that has one meaning of the word. According to Matthews (1974: 82) compounding is a process by which a compound lexeme is derived from two or more simpler lexeme. It is a combination from form lexemes to not simply form.

According to O'Grady and Dobrovolsky (1987: 139) English orthography is not consistent in representing compounds since they are sometimes written as single words, sometimes with an intervening hyphen, and sometime as separate words. Booij (2005: 93) said that compounds are combinations of two or more lexeme. Compound word is a new word that formed from two or more morphemes. Related to O'Grady (1997:119) who said that a morpheme is the smallest unit of language that carriage information about meaning or function.

Katamba (1993: 311) states that there are three types of compound; 1) Endocentric compounds, that is compounds with a head. 2) Exocentric compound, headless compound. 3) Copulative compounds are compounds that have two words which are coupled or conjoined.

According to British Phonographic Industry, Westlife has been certified for 12 million albums and 8.4 million singles in UK. Westlife also won ITV's "Record of the Year" four times in a row with

their singles. In Indonesia, their debut album won 20 times platinum award. The researcher thinks that Westlife's song is very good and pleasant to be heard, not only the lyrics but also the singer's voice. Westlife's song lyrics also have a good moral value, almost of their songs tell us about faithful, true love, and the struggle to get something.

Based on the explanation above, the study is inspired to analyze the compound words used in Westlife song lyrics Unbreakable V1 Greatest Hits Album Beginning 1999-2002.

Analysis is separation into parts, possibly with commencement and judgment. (Webster: 1989). This is a branch of mathematics which studies continuous changes and includes the theories of integration, differentiation, measure, limits, analytic functions and infinite series. It is the systematic study of real and complex-valued continuous functions. It describes both the discipline of which calculus is a part and one form of the abstract logic theory. There are two broad subdivisions of analysis named Real analysis and complex analysis, which deal with the real-values and the complex-valued functions respectively. Real Analysis: Real analysis is a branch of analysis that studies concepts of sequences and their limits, continuity, differentiation, integration and

sequences of functions. It focuses on the real numbers, including positive and negative infinity to form the extended real line. It deals with functions of real variables and is most commonly used to distinguish that portion of calculus. It is natural to consider differentiable, smooth or harmonic functions in the real analysis, which is more widely applicable but may lack some more powerful properties that holomorphic functions have. Complex analysis: Complex analysis is the study of complex numbers together with their manipulation, derivatives and other properties. It is an extremely powerful tool which helps in providing a way of computing difficult integrals by investigating the singularities of the function near and between the limits of integration.

Word as a part of language has important rule in forming a language. According to Fromkn et al. (2014 33), "Words are an important part of linguistic knowledge and constitute a component of our mental grammars. It means that word is important things in linguistic which has content combination. Francis (1985 207-208) classifies the word in four types. They are simple words, complex words, compound words and complex-compound.

Word Formation Process

It is one of Linguistics branches, study about word formation. According to Okeke, Onyebuchr, Obast. Tochukwu (2014 2216), "A word formation process a way in which an entirely word comes into a language and or a way in which a speaker creates complex words from already existing simpler word(s) " It means that word formation process is a way whereby a word in language is formed.

A compound is a word composed of more than one free morpheme. According to Delabunty and Garvey (2010) a morpheme is the smallest part of a word that has grammatical function or meaning; it is not the smallest unit of meaning. This definition of morpheme is supported by Stageberg (1999) who says that a morpheme is a short segment of language that meets three criteria: it is a word or a part of word that has meaning; it cannot be divided into smaller meaningful parts without violation of its meaning, and it occurs in differing verbal environments with a relatively stable meaning. In short, it can be said that morpheme is a smallest meaningful unit.

According to Katamba (1993: 305) the types of compound are: Endocentric Compounds. Katamba (1993: 311) said that, most compound in English are endocentric, they have a head. In such compound, normally the head element appears as the right-handmost constituent of the word. Semantically an endocentric

compound indicates a sub-grouping within the class of entities that the head denotes. There are the examples with the head is underlined; a schoolboy is a kind of a boy and a bedroom is a kind of room.

Exocentric Compounds or bahuvrihi compounds are headless compounds which do not contain an element that function as the semantic head which is modified by the no head element. The constituents in exocentric compounds do not have a head-modifier semantic relationship, for examples; a blue-nose is not a nose at all but a purplish variety of potato grown in Nova Scotian, and white-collar is neither a kind of a collar nor a white thing, but the meaning is something which is related with a worker. From semantic point of view, exocentric compounds are opaque. Their meaning often cannot be transparently guessed from its constituent parts like idioms.

Copulative compounds or dvanda compounds in the Sanskrit name are compounds that have two words which are couple or conjoined. They have the structure shown in: - girl (N) + friend (N) = girlfriend (N), - bitter (A)+ sweet (N) = bitter-sweet (A).

Types of compound word by the meaning are transparent words, these are the meanings of the words can be predicted from the each constituents of the word. For example: seaweed is a kind of weed

that grows in the sea, fleabite is a bite given by a flea, etc.,

Opaque words are the meaning is not predictable to be determined from the meaning of their constituents. For example: butterfingers is neither a kind of fingers nor a kind of butter but rather a person who is apparently in capable of holding things without dropping them.

From a syntactic point of view, copulative compounds are headed. But from a semantic point of view, the coupled elements are equal status, with neither element being regarded as the head that dominates the entire word. Related to Ullmann (1972: 81) every compound contains words which are arbitrary and opaque, without any connection between sound and sense, and others which are at least to some degree motivated and transparent

Song based on Cambridge Advance Learner's Dictionary means a usually short piece of music with words which are sung.' Whereas Oxford Advance Learners' Dictionary defines song is a short piece of music with words that you sing. Another definition of song is an artistic form of expression based on sound, generally considered a single (and often standalone) work of music with distinct and fixed pitches, pattern, and form. It can be wordless or with words, but must include some form of vocalization.

The word music was derived from Greek from the words "mousike techne" who inspired creativity that were called as Muses (the art of the muses)." Then it led to the word Latin as "musica". In English music defines as vocal or instrumental sounds (or both) combined in such a way as to produce beauty of form, harmony, and expression of motion.' Music also defined as sound that is arranged in a way that is pleasant or exciting to listen to." Another definition, music is a patterns of sounds made by musical instruments, singing or computers, or a combination of these, intended to give pleasure to people who listen to it.' Based on the definition above music is vocal or instrumental sound or combination of those that is arranged to give pleasure to someone.

The word "lyric" was actually derived from the Greek, specifically from word "lyrikos", meaning "singing to the lyre,"s as a form of poem and today, the meaning of lyrics is also rooted in the idea of music since the reference to a song's words as lyrics that appeared in 1876. Cambridge Advanced Learner's Dictionary defines song as the words of a song, especially a pop song.' But now lyrics not only for pop song, but also for another genre of sing. Oxford Advanced Learning Dictionary also defines lyric as

expressing person's personal feeling and thoughts connected with a poem or a song." A song without lyric cannot be called as song but only music or instrumental music. Based on the definition above, we can conclude that lyric is a personal feeling that written in for poem or song that express one's emotion.

Westlife are an Irish pop vocal group, who were formed in 1998 in Sligo, Ireland. They disbanded in 2012 and reunited in 2018. They were originally signed by Simon Cowell in the UK, Clive Davis in the US and managed by Louis Walsh and Sonny Takhar. The group currently consists of Shane Filan, Mark Feehily, Kian Egan, and Nicky Byrne, with Brian McFadden having left in 2004 to pursue a solo career.

So far, they have a total of thirteen major album releases, eleven of which are studio albums. Five albums are as a five-piece and eight are as a four-piece. The group rose to fame with their debut international self-titled studio album, *Westlife* (1999). It was followed by *Coast to Coast* (2000), *World of Our Own* (2001), *Unbreakable – The Greatest Hits Vol. 1* (2002), and *Turnaround* (2003), which continued the group's success worldwide. Before the start of their *Turnaround Tour* in 2004, one of the original members, Brian McFadden, departed from the band. The four remaining members continued as a group to release their cover albums *Allow Us to Be Frank*

(2004) and *The Love Album* (2006) and the studio albums *Face to Face* (2005) and *Back Home* (2007). After an almost one-year hiatus of studio recording in 2008, they regrouped and released the studio albums *Where We Are* (2009), and *Gravity* (2010), and the compilation album *Greatest Hits* (2011). After eight years, the quartet group released their eleventh studio album, *Spectrum*, in 2019.

The band has sold over 45 million records. The band has received over 1.5 billion views on their official YouTube channel alone with more than 2.4 million page subscribers as well, were streamed more than 300 million times, and more than 550 million streams on Spotify as of 2018 and more than a million followers on the said streaming media platform as of May 2019.

They generated singles such as "Swear It Again", "If I Let You Go", "Flying Without Wings", "I Have a Dream", "Seasons in the Sun", "Fool Again", "My Love", "What Makes a Man", "Uptown Girl", "Unbreakable", "When You're Looking Like That", "Queen of My Heart", "Mandy", "Tonight", "Hey Whatever", "You Raise Me Up", "Bop Bop Baby", "The Rose", and "World of Our Own". 19 out their 29 singles as lead artist and as featured artist received UK certifications from 1999 to 2019, 17 out of 29 singles from 1999 to 2009 reached the top 2 on the UK Singles Chart. They have the second most

certifications for a boy band in the UK Singles Chart after Take That and the most singles certifications for a pop band on the UK number one singles artists chart since The Beatles.

According to the British Phonographic Industry (BPI), Westlife has been certified for 13.1 million albums, 1.3 million video albums, and 10 million singles, with a total of more than 24 million combined sales in the UK. They are also currently ranked 19th with the most number-one albums of all time and sixth highest band in the list. The group have accumulated 14 number-one singles as a lead artist as well as having eight number-one albums in the United Kingdom, making them Ireland's most prolific chart-toppers. In 2012, the Official Charts Company listed Westlife 34th amongst the biggest-selling singles artist, 16th amongst the biggest selling groups, and 14th with most top ten hits all the highest for a boy band and a pop group in British music history. They are the biggest selling album group of the 2000s decade in the UK as well. Three of their studio albums were part of the 50 fastest selling albums of all time in the UK. The group have the most consecutive number-one studio albums in a decade in the UK and Ireland for a band since the Beatles and for a pop band and act since ABBA. Also in Ireland, they have 11 number-one albums with a

total of 13 top two albums, 16 number-one singles as well as 34 top-fifty singles.

They are holders of the following Guinness World Records: first to achieve seven consecutive number-one singles in the UK, most public appearances in 36 hours by a pop group, most singles to debut at number one on the UK chart and top selling album group in the United Kingdom in the 21st century.

It makes Westlife one of the most successful musical groups of all time, among the highest profile acts in 2000s popular culture in most territories worldwide, and one of the few boy bands to have continued success after their commercial peak. On the best-selling boy bands of all-time list, they are currently eighth worldwide along with the biggest selling boy band from Ireland in history globally.

RESEARCH DESIGN

The study applies descriptive quantitative because this collects, analyzes, describes, identifies the data and finally counts them. Qualitative research is more subjective in nature than Quantitative research and involves examining and reflecting on the less tangible aspects of a research subject, e.g, values, attitudes, perceptions (Neville: 6).

The data are selected from Song Lyrics of Westlife Unbreakable VI Greatest Hits Album Beginning

1999-2002. The last instrument is the English dictionary. The English dictionaries were used to check the part of speech of compound words found in the Song Lyrics of Westlife Unbreakable V1 Greatest Hits Album Beginning 1999-2002. The data collected are further analyzed by the following procedures: First, Presenting the data. Second, Identifying the compound words found in every song. Third, Making group of the compound words from 20 songs. Fourth, determining lyrics of the song. Fifth, Counting the number of compound words. Sixth, arranging the compound words based on the frequency of occurrence. Seventh, concluding them.

First, identifying the compound words. They were identified in the observation field note by recognizing the characteristics of compound words using Katamba's theories.

Second, classifying the compound words into three types. They were endocentric, exocentric and copulative.

Last, interpreting the contextual meaning of those compound words to be more specifically.

FINDING AND CONCLUSION

There were 98 words identified as the compound word in the Song Lyrics of Westlife Unbreakable V1 Greatest Hits Album Beginning 1999-2002. The analysis was viewed from the word formation called compounding. After

the process called identification, the researcher classified those words into three types of compound word, so there were three types of compound word. They were endocentric, exocentric, and copulative compound word. It is about 54.08% or 53 words were classified as the endocentric compound words because of the combination of the head and the modifier. 17 words or about 17.34% was classified as the exocentric compound words because of the absence of the head. Moreover, about 28.57% or 28 words were categorized as the copulative compound words because of the meanings that conjoin together. The researcher concluded that the contextual meanings of the compound words found in the Song Lyrics of Westlife Unbreakable V1 Greatest Hits Album Beginning 1999-2002 were interpreted by the researcher successfully. The contextual meanings were magnificently interpreted by the researcher by analyzing the word formation used

The finding is hoped to be useful to motivate students to learn the compound word to enlarge their knowledge towards English grammar. The students should understand better the compound word because they can find the compound words in learning English as the foreign language. The teacher can use song as the teaching media in teaching compound word because it is the effective media in teaching compound word. For other

researchers who will conduct the research with the same topic can use this research as their references. For the readers, especially the students of English Department better choose the analysis of compound words as the object of research, because there are many interesting aspects which can be analyzed. Sometimes, people do not realize some words that appear in a reading are kind of compound words. They think that those words are single word, but actually they are new words which are built through the process of compounding.

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
